



# Innovating Collection with the Automated Side Loader

Operated by a single driver from inside the truck, the automatic side loader utilizes a mechanical arm with a claw to pick up a cart from the curb. When grasping onto the cart, the claw makes a secure grip around the widest part of the cart body. After gripping onto the cart, the mechanical arm lifts the cart up, dumping waste into the top front of the garbage truck. Waste is then forced through an aperture into the main body and compacted toward the rear of the truck. The driver is able to then reset the cart in its original curbside position.

# Safety First




#### **Drive Cam**

Below are the cart placement instructions and requirements necessary for pick up.



Please have recycling at the curb by 7 AM on collection day.



PLEASE PLACE ALL RECYCLABLES INSIDE THE GREEN CART WITH YELLOW LID.

Additional recyclables outside the cart will not be serviced.



Please place cart 5 feet from obstructions (such as vehicles or mailboxes) within 1 foot from curb. Carts can not block the sidewalk.



Do not overfill recycling carts. Lids must close securely.



Do not obstruct collection of carts by parking vehicles in the vicinity. Keep area clear for easy access by collection truck.









# Important Information



Please have trash cart at the curb by 7 AM on collection day.



PLEASE PLACE ALL TRASH INSIDE THE CART. There is an additional charge for each extra bag that doesn't fit in your cart with the lid closed.



Do not overfill trash carts. Lids must close securely.
